Entrances: Boole Tree, Princess, Hume Junction Gate, Yucca Point Gate, Big Stump Entrance, Ash Mountain Entrance, Lookout Point Entrance.

Visitor Centers: Cedar Grove Visitor Center and Village (4635ft 1412m), Kings Canyon Visitor Center Grant Grove Village (6589ft 2008m), Montecito-Sequoia Lodge, Stony Creek Village (closed in winter), Giant Forest Museum (6409ft 1954m), Foothills Visitor Center Park Headquarters (1700ft 518m), Mineral King Ranger Station (7504ft 2287m).

Lodges: Kings Canyon Lodge (closed in winter), Montecito-Sequoia Lodge, Stony Creek Village (closed in winter), Dorst Creek (6720ft 2048m), Wuksachi Lodge, Lodgepole Visitor Center and Village (6720ft 2048m), Pear Lake (9200ft 2804m), Bearpaw Meadow (7800ft 2377m), Silver City Resort.

Landmarks: General Grant Tree, Sentinel Dome (9115ft 2718m), North Dome (8717ft 2657m), Grand Sentinel (8518ft 2596m), Buck Rock (8500ft 2591m), Mount Silliman (11188ft 3410m), Little Baldy (8044ft 2452m), Moro Rock (6725ft 2050m), Hospital Rock, Castle Rocks (9180ft 2798m), Atwell Mill (6540ft 1993m), Cold Springs (7830ft 2387m).

Trails: Grizzly Falls, Lewis Creek Trail, Hume Lake, Buck Rock, Big Meadows, JO Pass (9410ft 2868m), Silliman Pass (10479ft 3194m), High Sierra Trail, Tharps Log, Tunnel Log, Paradise Ridge Trail, Atwell-Hockett Trail, Tar Gap Trail.

Roads: Highway 180, Highway 198, Kings Canyon Highway, Generals Highway, Muir Grove, Colony Mill Trail.

Water Features: Kings River, South Fork Kings River, Roaring River, Stony Creek, Weaver Lake, Jennie Lake, Seville Lake, Twin Lakes, Heather Lake, Moose Lake, Mosquito Lakes, Big Bird Lake, Tamarack Lake.

Other: No gasoline sold in parks, Road closed in winter, Roads open summer only, Vehicles longer than 22 feet are prohibited, Parking: Summer—only with disability placard. Winter—open except when shuttle operates.
